We are working hard at loving these people and teaching them the importance of living a separated Christian life, changing their home environments to one that will please the Lord, training our people to reach the world for Jesus, starting right here in Guyana first.

Acts 1:8 "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth." We had our second Missions Conference in May. Ever since our first Mission Conference last year, we picked up our first missionary in the Philippines; the people are faithful at giving. We have a large number that goes out soul winning with us now each week. They take tracts home every week and pass them out. Our numbers are growing! It brings joy to our hearts when new people come to church and when we say "Did someone invite?" and they say a church members name! We are praising the Lord at the spiritual growth and unity within our church family.

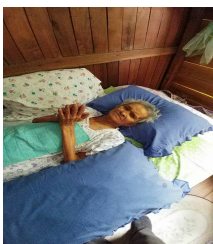
CHILDREN'S HOME NEWS:
